

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- While it is Summer and a time in which one is out of school, we have a standard to uphold. All participants must wear shoes and socks at all times. We also request that each student either wear loose fitting shorts or pants with a shirt which covers from the waist to below the neck and shoulder to shoulder. Please avoid clothing with lettering other than OLPH gear. In short, the dress code is casual but respectful of others.
- To keep some order, we need all participants to be present by 9 AM unless a previous arrangement was made for a later time or absence. The day ends at 4:00 PM. Unfortunately we cannot offer after program care beyond 4:30 PM. If your child needs oversight beyond this time, we will have to find other means. We do not have any programs for this though.
- Please pack a healthy lunch and snacks. This should include a drink as well.
- Life is unpredictable. Please fill out all forms provided before the first session in the event of an unpredictable emergency. We want what is best for your children just as much as you do but we cannot offer that without your help. Please help us help your children.
- All classes will be taught by certified teachers but aides may not be certified. All adults will undergo strict screening, FBI/BCI, fingerprinting, and VIRTUS training.

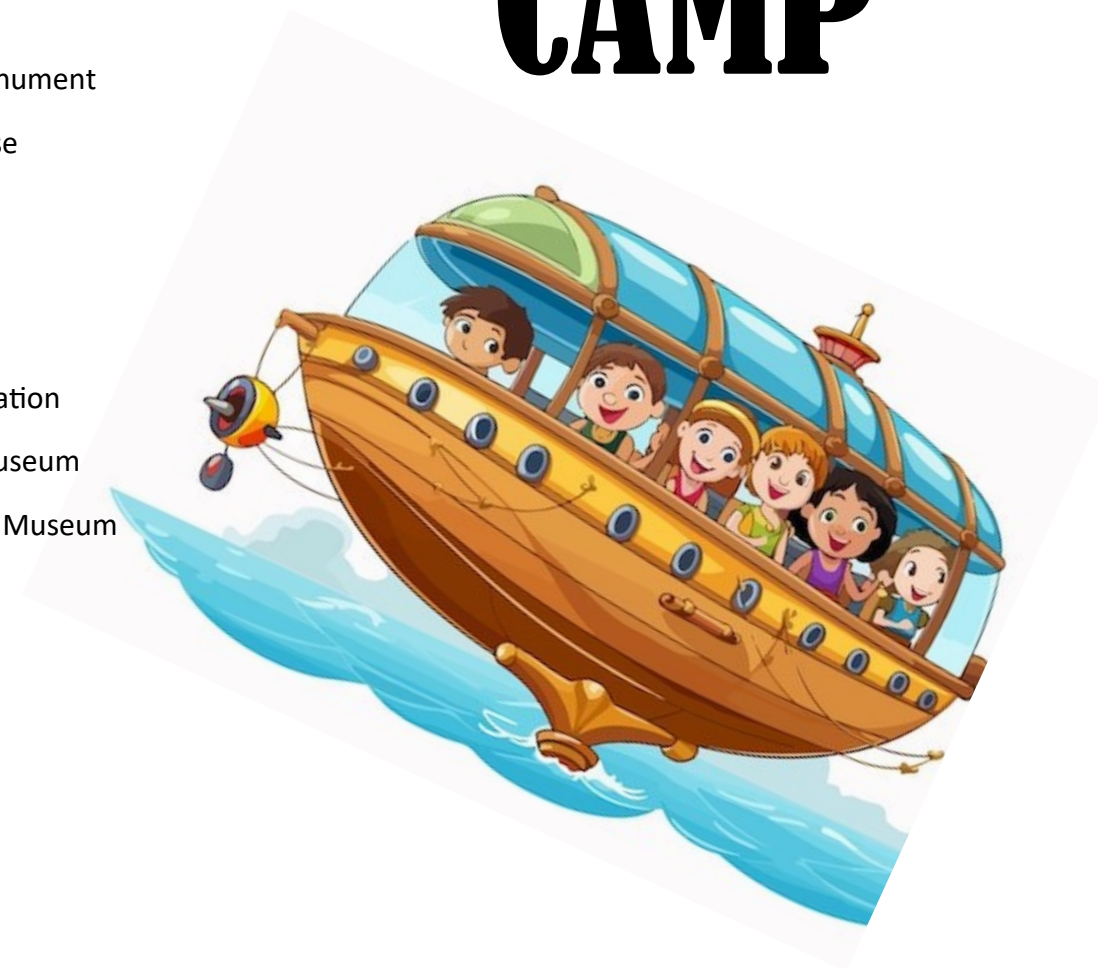

HOW TO APPLY

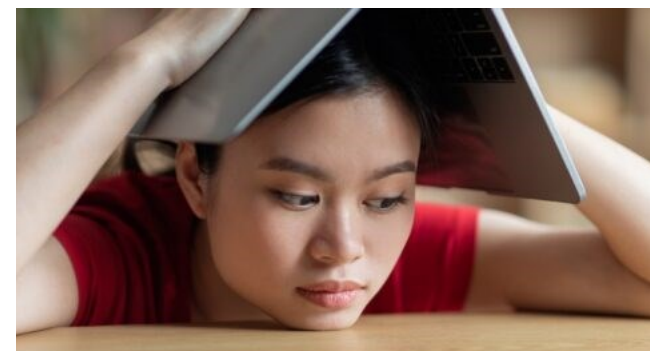
REGISTER ONLINE!
