

Our Lady of Perpetual Help Dress Code

General

All students must be dressed respectfully and appropriately for a school setting
School administration will make the final decision as to what is appropriate dress.

Kindergarten

Kindergarten students are not required to wear uniforms. Kindergarteners should be dressed comfortably to allow for movement. Jeans and sweatpants are not permitted. Shirts with writing or pictures should be appropriate for the school setting. Any color tennis shoe is permitted for kindergarten.

Shorts can be worn from April 1 to October 31. All other guidelines regarding shoes and general appearance are the same as grades 1-8 students.

Grades 1-8 Uniform

The plaid uniform jumper or skirt for girls is available from SchoolBelles. Grades 1 through 3 wear the uniform plaid jumper. Grades 6 through 8 can wear the uniform plaid skirt.

Girls

- Shirts** Long or short sleeved polo's or blouses can be worn. Turtlenecks or mock turtlenecks can also be worn. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Shirt colors permitted: dark green, gray, and white. Banded shirts from Schoolbells may also be worn. Blouses should be white. Shirts worn under dress shirt must be plain white and hidden from view.
- Pants** Plain twill uniform pants. Pants must have no labels and are to be worn around the waist – no low-rise pants permitted. No cargo pants or pants with rivets are permitted. Pant colors: navy for grades 1-5. Navy or khaki grades 6-8.
- Skirts, Skorts Jumpers** Grades 1-3 wear Schoolbelles jumper. Grades 4-8 can wear Schoolbelles plaid skirt or skort. Skirts and skorts must be no more than 4" from the floor and cannot be rolled at the waist.
- Shorts** Dress knee-length shorts may be worn between April 1 – October 31. Shorts may not have rivets, or labels. Cargo shorts are not permitted. Colors: Navy grades 1-8; khaki grades 6-8.
- Sweaters** V-neck or round neck pullover or cardigan can be worn over uniform shirt/jumper. Colors permitted: gray, white, dark green.
- Sweatshirt** Crewneck embroidered with the green OLPH logo on left – must be purchased through OLPH school. Color: gray with green logo. No hoodies.
- Belts** Must be worn with all pants and shorts, unless pants have elastic waist grades. No belts for grades 1-3 only. Colors: navy, black, or brown.
- Socks** Must be one solid color with no insignias. Must be visible above the shoe.
- Shoes** Either tennis or dress shoes can be worn the uniform. Colors permitted for tennis shoes: white, black, gray/silver and navy blue. Dress shoes colors: must be one solid color, either brown, black, navy, tan, or white. No colored laced or lights. All shoes must have a completely enclosed toe and heel. The shoe heel must be no more than one inch in height. No boots/ankle boots, crocs, or Ugg type shoes/slippers are not permitted.

Boys

- Shirts** Long or short sleeved polo's or dress shirts can be worn. Turtleneck or mock turtlenecks can also be worn. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Shirt colors permitted: dark green, gray, and white. Dress shirts must be white. Shirts worn under dress shirt must be plain white and hidden from view.
- Pants** Plain twill uniform pants. Pants must have no labels and worn around the waist – no low-rise pants permitted. No cargo pants or pants with rivets are permitted. Pant colors: navy for grades 1-5. Navy or khaki grades 6-8.
- Shorts** Dress knee-length shorts may be worn between April 1 – October 31. Shorts may not have rivets, or labels. Cargo shorts are not permitted. Colors: Navy grades 1-8; khaki grades 6-8.
- Sweaters** V-neck or round neck pullover or cardigan can be worn over uniform shirt. Colors: gray, white, black, dark green.
- Sweatshirt** Crewneck embroidered with the green OLPH logo on left – must be purchased through OLPH school. Color: gray with green logo. No hoodies.
- Belts** Must be worn with all pants and shorts, unless pants have elastic waist grades 1-5 only. Colors: navy, black, brown.
- Socks** Must be one solid color with no insignias. Must be visible above the shoe.
- Shoes** Either tennis or dress shoes can be worn the uniform. Colors permitted for tennis shoes: white, black, gray/silver and navy blue. Dress shoes colors: must be one solid color, either brown, black, navy, tan, or white. No colored laced or lights. All shoes must have a completely enclosed toe and heel.

Misc. Dress Code Notes:

Leggings can only be worn under skirts or jumpers.

No clothing, including jeans worn on a Jeans Day, may be ripped or torn.

- Hair** Must be neat, clean, and out of student's eyes. No fad haircuts, hair carvings, twisty hairstyles, or artificial hairpieces.
- Jewelry** All jewelry must be modest. Earrings cannot be longer or bigger than one inch.
- Makeup** Is not permitted. Nail polish must be one solid color and nails must be athletic in length for the safety of all students. No glued on fingernails. No hear coverings may be worn in the building. No chains or jewelry that alludes to sex drugs, alcohol, gangs, or the occult. No tattoos of any kind, including temporary tattoos.
